

**Notre Dame of Maryland University**  
**ARP – Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund III**

The American Rescue Plan (ARP), was passed on March 11, 2021 and authorized the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF) III.

As a part of the previous Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Securities (CARES) Act, **Notre** Dame of Maryland University (“NDMU” or “the University”) signed and returned a Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students on April 10, 2020. An updated Certification and Agreement for HEERF III was automatically approved upon drawing down funds.

NDMU received \$1,446,996 from the U.S. Department of Education (“USDE”) to award Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students.

As of June 30, 2021, NDMU has distributed \$1,446,996 in Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students from the “Student Aid Portion” of funds received from USDE, as well as
